A powerful, full-bodied wine with strong fruit flavours of apricots and peaches, citrus zest on the finish.
- 2021 Côtes-du-Rhône, Samorens Blanc, Domaine Ferraton** £34.00
Aromatic nose of white flowers and stone fruits, with a freshness of fruit and an appealing savoury finish.
- 2022 Château Haut Maginet, Bordeaux Blanc, Bordeaux** £36.00
A blend of 60% Sauvignon Blanc, 20% Sémillon & 20% Muscadelle. Citrus, herb and flint aromas lead to a crisp, medium-bodied palate.
- 2021 Chablis, Jean-Marc Brocard, Burgundy** £58.00
Un-oaked with a pure and mineral nose with citrus notes and a dry, crisp finish.
- 2018 Pouilly-Fuissé, Domaine Béranger, Burgundy** £66.00
Golden in colour, with a pure, gentle bouquet.
- 2018 Montagny 1er Cru, Henri de Villamont, Burgundy** £70.00
Richly vibrant white burgundy, creamy texture on the palate cut with some citrus freshness.

Fragrant, floral nose with ripe citrus, peach fruit and some creamy oak notes.

- 2018 Rioja, Crianza, Conde Valdemar, Spain** £38.00
Powerful, mature berry aromas with spicy accents.
- 2022 Nero D'Avola, Kore, Colomba Bianca, Sicily** £39.00
An intense bouquet from this organic wine of rich brambly fruits with a note of black pepper spice.
- 2020 Pena Roble, Ribera Del Duero, Spain** £46.50
Expressive aromas of red fruits, sweet cherry and hints of liquorice with oaky undertones.
- 2019 Cassa Douro Reserva, Portugal** £41.00
Dense with ripe blackberries, elegant floral hints alongside subtle spice and vanilla notes.

Intense aromas and flavours of orange rind, apricot and honey that carry through to a beautifully balanced and persistent finish.
- 2018 La Fleur D'Or, Sauternes, France** £50.00/37.5cl
Apricot fruit, creamy patisserie notes and a certain citrus brightness on the nose leads to a sweet yet beautifully balanced palate.
