Aromas of apricot, flora and honey precede a plush, concentrated palate of citrus and stone fruits.
- 2020 Chablis, Jean-Marc Brocard, Burgundy** £48.00
Un-oaked with a pure and mineral nose with citrus notes and a dry, crisp finish.
- 2016 Pouilly Fuissé, Domaine Nadine Ferrand, Burgundy** £60.00
Golden in colour, with a pure, gentle bouquet.
- 2018 Montagny 1er Cru, Henri de Villamont, Burgundy** £70.00
Richly vibrant white burgundy, creamy texture on the palate cut with some citrus freshness.
- 2017 Rully 1er Cru Grésigny, Domaine Paul et Marie Jacqueson, Burgundy** £80.00
Fragrant, floral nose with ripe citrus, peach fruit and some creamy oak notes.

Round, soft and fruity, medium dry but with a definite hint of sweetness.
- 2020 Tramari, Rosé di Primitivo, San Marzano, Italy** £28.50
Softly rosé-coloured with a balanced and refreshing style, subtle fruity overtones.
- 2020 La Berle, Côtes de Provence, Michel Roux, Gassin** £38.50
From the grapes from the vineyard of the late Michel Roux and bottled by his neighbours at Château Minuty, this is classic, dry and subtly flavoured Provence rosé.
